Topic: Library study space vs. home desk · Shared traits belong in the middle, not repeated on both sides.

LIBRARY ONLY	BOTH	HOME DESK ONLY
• Quiet rules reduce interruptions. • Reference books and staff help are nearby. • Hours and travel time limit access.	• Can support reading and writing. • Can provide a desk, light, and Wi-Fi. • Work better when distractions are managed. Middle = similarities that are true of both choices.	• Available without travel. • Personal supplies can stay set up. • Household noise may be harder to control.
